## Project target groups



- Main beneficiaries

  - Further NSDI stakeholders (e.g. other governmental institutions, private surveying, Geospatial commercial sector, Research organisations, etc.)











#### Policy, Institutional and legislative framework analysis

- Description of the structures available in each country
  - Policy documents and strategies
  - Laws and regulations
  - Governmental and non-governmental institutions
- Assessment of the effectiveness of the framework in view of its implementation
- Gap analysis of the existing framework in view of INSPIRE requirements.

#### **Outputs: 2 regional and 7 national reports**













#### **Capacity Building and Knowledge Transfer**

- Assessment and description of already existing capacities
- Analysis and recommendations
- Trainings with to goal to contribute to improvements of end-user processes and services
- Workshops in each beneficiary country <u>Outputs:</u> 2 reports, 2 regional conferences, 3 regional trainings, 14 national workshops











#### **Awareness Raising and Communication**

- Assessment and analysis of the current situation
  - E.g. Public awareness activities of the beneficiaries for SDI and land administration
- Recommendations on how to enhance public awareness, including a public awareness campaign
- Implementation of concrete actions
  - Pilot and demonstrator projects
  - Ideas competition with students
  - Press conferences

<u>Outputs:</u> 2 studies, public awareness campaign, INSPIRE days & INSPIRE Forum, Website, European Conference

# Success factors of setting up national SDIs



- Create <u>political support</u> via an SDI council
- Build a <u>consensus process</u> build on common interests and create a common vision
- Establish the <u>institutional and policy framework</u>: Policy, copyright, licensing and other rights to the use of data and information must be addressed and agreed
- Make spatial <u>data and metadata available and</u> <u>accessible:</u> this is the essence of SDI

How can INSPIRATION contribute to achieving these goals?



- Creation of <u>political support</u>: Awareness raising and communication activities, including the "INSPIRATION ideas competition" (Activity 3)
- Establish the <u>institutional and policy framework</u> -Policy, copyright, licensing and other rights to the use of data and information must be addressed and agreed: *Support in law drafting and individual country recommendations on legal and institutional issues (Activity 1)*
- <u>Focus on skills</u>: *Regional approach for capacity building and education (Activity 2)*
